❖ Exam Exemptions Procedures for Grades 9-12 (each semester):

- 90 or above average AND no more than 4 absences for the semester
- 80 or above average AND no more than 2 absences for the semester
- 70 or above average AND no absences for the semester
- Absences are accumulated by each class period
- 3 tardies to class and/or school equals 1 unexcused absence
- ANY unexcused absence will result in the student forfeiting the exemption for that class
- Any suspensions will forfeit the exam exemption for the semester of the suspension.

❖ Semester Credits: Successful completion of one semester of a course is equivalent to .5 credit in that course. Students who have a failing grade (59 or below) at the end of the semester will not earn credit for that semester.

❖ HEALTH class: Unit deadlines are listed in the calendar of events and on the form that was given to them. Students can work ahead at any time. ***Students must be 100% complete with this class by Dec. 13 to receive credit. If they don't receive credit, they will have to retake this class during 2nd semester.**

- **Exam Exemption!!!** Due to full participation on the WorkKeys test, all Seniors will be awarded one Exam exemption for the upcoming fall exams.
- **Semester Credits for Seniors:** Any Senior that fails first semester will be placed in credit recover for the second semester (will lose an elective).
