General Information

- Summer School Dates: June 6, 2022, through July 22, 2022
- Summer School Grades: 5th-12th grade (limited to two courses)
- All courses will be delivered virtually using Edgenuity. Instructors will communicate with students using MS TEAMS for student conferences and tutoring.
- Summer School Orientation will be held via MS TEAMS after the student has been registered and enrolled in their course/s. All classwork must be completed by Friday, July 22, 2022, at 11:59 p.m.
- The St. Clair County Code of Conduct policies and regulations will apply to summer school students.
 - All cell phones must be turned off and placed into a container. They will be held in the office until dismissal.
 - Any student who violates the policies and regulations in the Code of Conduct will be suspended from Summer School and receive a failing grade.
 - Any student who misses two (2) in person meetings without a medical or court excuse will be suspended from Summer School and receive a failing grade.
- Cost: No cost to students recovering FAILED courses from the 21-22 school year (limited to two (2) core classes).
- Cost: \$350 per class
