

Providing all students access to school meals is a priority for the St. Clair County Schools Child Nutrition Program. Beginning on August 20th, meals will be available daily to all students enrolled in St. Clair County Schools. If your child is at school for traditional learning, they will have access to meals from the cafeteria. If your child is a hybrid or virtual student, meals will be available daily through curbside pick-up.

Please understand that this daily curbside meal pick-up is different from the meal pick-up that occurred during the school closure and over the summer. Your child must be enrolled in a St. Clair County School to receive these meals and the meal price will be based on your child's lunch status of Free, Reduced, or Full Paid. If your child is free, these meals will be available at no cost to you. If your child is reduced or full paid, you will be responsible for payment of these meals and will need to add money to your child's lunch account to cover these meals.

We encourage you to complete a Free/Reduced Meal application as soon as possible to see if you qualify for assistance. Paper applications will be sent home on the first day of school. For faster processing and privacy, we encourage you to complete the online application by visiting the St. Clair County Schools website.

All students will be given a lunch card on the first day of school. This card will be used in the cafeteria for touchless checkout. Lunch cards for hybrid students can be picked up at the school office where your child is enrolled. This card can serve as identification for hybrid and virtual students and should be presented in the curbside pick-up line to receive school meals. If your child doesn't have a lunch card yet, other proof of school enrollment will be accepted.

If your child is a hybrid student, meals will be available daily through curbside pick-up at the school your child is enrolled.

If your child is a student of the Virtual Preparatory Academy, they will be allowed to pick-up meals curbside at the cafeteria of their zoned school.

On staggered start days, meals for traditional students who are not required to be on campus that day will be offered through curbside pick-up at the site where your child is enrolled. On days your child is attending school traditionally, meals will be served from the cafeteria.

Meal pick-up times and locations will be unique to each school campus. Please visit the website of the school your child attends for information related to curbside pick-up options and to complete the meal sign-up sheet. Signing up is not required to receive meals, but please understand that this will help our lunchroom staff be better prepared for your arrival. Students can receive a breakfast and lunch during each pick-up. We hope that you will take advantage of the healthy meals being served at your child's school. Picking up meals will be a great way to get out of the house for a few minutes during your hybrid or virtual school day! We can't wait to serve you in our cafeterias or in our curbside pick-up lines.
