Large, insulated water jugs are required of all members. Disposable, clear water bottles and uninsulated containers are prohibited. Bring a durable, insulated water jug every day with enough capacity for a day of hard work.

BAND CALENDAR AND PERFORMANCE SCHEDULE

Stay up to date on band events and rehearsals by keeping the latest version of the band calendar on hand throughout the year. Revisions will be posted on Remind throughout the summer and via e-mail updates when school is in session to all members and parents.

BAND/AUXILIARY COURSE REGISTRATION: All auxiliary members must enroll in the 8th period marching band class. Auxiliary members also are encouraged but not required to play an instrument in a concert ensemble throughout the year. All playing members must enroll and remain in 8th period band class throughout the year. Students withdrawing to VPA must attend all in and out-of-school rehearsals and performances to maintain band membership. Those who fail to meet attendance requirements will become alternate members or could be dismissed from the organization.

SCHOOL REGISTRATION: If in-person school registration days conflict with band camp, students are to remain at camp while parents attend any in-person registration activities. Plan to remain at camp every day until dismissal.
